

**SUPERIOR COURT OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA
ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 19-11**

**Extension of Time for Applications to the Probate Fiduciary Panel
(Amending Administrative Order 19-06)**

WHEREAS, Administrative Order 19-06 set forth the requirements and timeline for applications to and the re-establishment of the Probate Fiduciary Panel; and

WHEREAS, Administrative Order 19-06 ordered that the Court establish a regular and ongoing process for re-establishing the Probate Fiduciary Panel on a predictable schedule and to otherwise establish a process to accept, at any time, applications from attorneys who wish to become a member of the Probate Fiduciary Panel during the time between the periodic re-establishment of the Panel; and

WHEREAS, it is the best interest of the administration of justice for the application to the Probate Fiduciary Panel to remain open until 5:00 p.m. on Monday, July 29, 2019, to permit the submission of additional applications;


NOW, THEREFORE, it is, by the Court,
