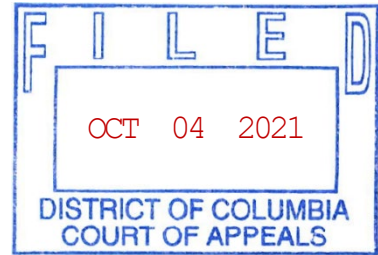

ORDER

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of Section (b)(1) and (2) of the District of Columbia Retired Judge Service Act, P.L. 98-598, D.C. Code § 11-1504 (b)(1) and (2) (2001), as amended by P.L. 99-573, Judge Phyllis D. Thompson has requested, and the District of Columbia Commission on Judicial Disabilities and Tenure has favorably recommended, that she be appointed as a Senior Judge of this Court.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Anna Blackburne-Rigsby, Chief Judge of the District of Columbia Court of Appeals, pursuant to the provisions of Sections (a)(1) and (b)(3) of D.C. Code § 11-1504 (2001), do hereby appoint the Honorable Phyllis D. Thompson to perform judicial duties as a Senior Judge of this Court for four years, to be effective on a date to be determined after her successor is appointed and qualifies. *See* D.C. Code § 11-1502 (2012 Repl.) (“Subject to mandatory retirement at age 74 and to the provisions of subchapters II and III of this chapter, a judge of a District of Columbia court appointed on or after the date of enactment of the District of Columbia Court Reorganization Act of 1970 shall serve for a term of fifteen years, and upon completion of such term, such judge shall continue to serve until the judge’s successor is appointed and qualifies.”).
