

ORDER

Suspending all Sentencing Provisions Requiring Service of Weekends in Jail

(3/27/2020)

In light of the current public health and judicial emergencies declared in response to the COVID-19 pandemic, and it is hereby ordered:

1. That all weekend in jail provisions of sentences in criminal cases are hereby suspended; and
2. This order shall remain in effect until June 5, 2020, at which time such weekends shall resume and be served until completion of the originally imposed number of weekends in jail are completed.
